



RAIL PONY / SCOOTER

Description:

Rail scooters are classed as lifting tackle and are built up in three parts: skate frame, main frame and camlock rail clamp set. They are manually handled and maneuvered along one rail and are normally used in pairs. Used for lifting and re-positioning lengths of rail, each scooter and attaching camlock has a safe working load of 750kgs.

Fastline Fred's Tips:



- Always make sure you have the correct number of scooters for the weight that is to be lifted.
- Always pre-calculate the weight of the rail you are wanting to lift so as not to try to lift more than the safe working load.
- Remember - UIC60 rail weighs more per meter than standard rail.
